“The efforts were directed towards eradicating alien plants”. Bobby Road: 90% Rooikranz, with 5% Acacia Myrtle. 3% Port Jackson, and 2% other species.

The collective commitment is always encouraging and appreciated. The positive temperament of the hackers is outstanding.
